



This is instructional function. Secondly the teacher creates the conditions in the classroom. This is the management function. The instructional function of the teacher of the teacher is the task related aspect of the teacher's role. This aspect of the role takes into account the ways in which the teacher can transmit information. . The management function focuses on the interpersonal aspect of the role in the classroom we find the two aspects of the role complement each other. ### The general qualities about the good teacher are as follows:

He should observe social changes and ready to do various types of experiments in his teaching. Teacher is a good classroom manager, calm and confident. He should develop his own ideal model before students while teaching learning process. He should understand the problems of the students. His teaching will be failure without it. His main goal should be innovative and is able to motivate students. Motivating learners would involve creating the right learning set or the readiness to learn and also ensuring that the learner's interest in the learning task is sustained. This is the basic function of the teacher when setting up a learning activity. Motivating and sustaining learner's motivation is largely dependent on the teacher's individual personality and attitude to the learners. A teacher can help motivate learners is by adopting a positive attitude to them and by communicating this attitude

to the learners through his interest in them and the learning task. These factors would contribute to the teachers teaching style. It is largely dependent on the individual teacher's personality. A student can learn through experience and observation, to change one's teaching style to suit the needs of the learning situation.

It is very important thing because students understand the classroom teaching of the teacher but it is difficult them to express the same topic among their friends. To develop this skill teacher will set up in the class. This activity will involve the teacher interacting with the learners as a whole group or as in the small group. The organization of the learning group is closely tied up with the instructional role of the teacher.
