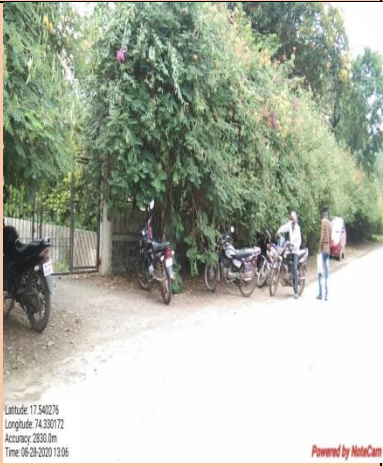


Policy on Green Campus Initiative:


Raja Shripatrao Bhagwantrao Mahavidyalaya, Aundh is situated in drought prone zone and hilly area of Khatav Tehsil and Satara district. The college has taken various initiatives to maintain and develop green campus. Availability of sufficient water is prime requirement for the development of any green campus. Fortunately, the college has its own bore-well with sufficient water at the Gymkhana playground with five horse power submersible suction motor pump. The college has already done pipeline up to the college from the playground to lift the water. The college has constructed ten thousand litter underground water storage tank where the water of the bore well is stored. Harvested rain water is also stored in the same tank and later on the stored water is lifted with one horse power submersible motor pump to the small plastic water tanks with two thousand litter capacity on the terrace of the college. Through various pipelines the water is circulated all over the plants and trees, labs, latrines, filters, and common drinking water place in the campus.

The college has already developed botanical garden with endangered and rare, medicinal plants. Other various plants are also planted in the campus. Name plates of the particular plants, with its Latin, vernacular and botanical names, are displayed below every plant so that everybody can easily understand and identify the plant properly. This specific work is done by the students of the department of Botany.

The institution has taken precaution of protecting old and huge trees and plants in the campus while developing new constructions. Save Tree Save Life motto is strictly followed by everyone in the campus. Approximately hundred flowering of different species are potted and placed in the college campus. Nobody is allowed to cut the tree or plant or pluck the flowers of any plant of the campus. All the peons are unanimously water the plants and trees weekly. Botany department continuously and sustainingly takes various initiatives and efforts along with students to protect and develop the green campus. As per the policy of Government of Maharashtra on Tree Plantation, students of the college are motivated to plant the trees, protect the plants, patron them and to take care. With the help of the students, the college takes initiative in tree plantation every year. Spreading the seeds on the Yamai Hill in rainy season is yearly activity of the college. The college has developed four vermicomposting units through which collected waste leaves of plants and trees are deposited into the units and the same is converted into pure bio-fertilizers with the help of earthworms. The fertilizer later on used by the farmers nearby.

The college has formed Tree Plantation Committee. Dr. Moholkar Suhan Mohan, Assistant Professor in Botany, is the chairperson of the committee along with four members. The committee devotedly looks after the green campus maintenance and development. The college has taken initiative and banned use of plastic carry bags, bottles, pouches in the campus. It has also restricted the entries of the vehicles in the campus on third Saturday of every month. Students from nearby areas of the college are motivated to use bicycles instead of fuel consuming vehicles. To maintain the campus healthy and eco-friendly, the college has declared the campus plastic and tobacco free zone.
