


Policy on Physically Challenged Students or Divyangjan


The institution has specific policy regarding physically challenged students or Divyangjans. As Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar said Learn, Unite and Struggle, each and every one has fundamental right to education. The institution never denies education to physically challenged students also. Such students are preferably allowed to take admission in the college. The college provides almost all kinds of support to such students and various facilities are also provided to them. Faculty of the college has deep sense of responsibility towards such students. They are always ready to support them mentally and physically. Help of teaching and non-teaching staff to these students make them secure, confident and also help them to maintain healthy relations with other normal students. In this way healthy atmosphere is maintained in the college where no such student feels isolated and insecure.

Some facilities are provided or available in the college for divyangjan students.

1. The college constructed Ramp at the entrance steps so that handicapped students who are unable to walk on the stairs can easily walk on the ramp.
2. Railing is also provided in the staircase of ground floor, first floor and second floor so that such students can climb the stairs with the help of railing on both sides.
3. Wheel Chair is also available in the campus. The students, who are completely unable to walk, can use wheel chair. Peons of the college help such students to reach desired place with the help of wheel chair.
4. The college also provides walker to divyangjan students or physically challenged students. The students who are unable to walk faster due to their injured legs can use walker. Their request is immediately fulfilled.
5. The college takes care of such students in their examinations also. They are provided separate room to face the examination. Separate internal senior supervisor is also appointed for the convenience of the student.
6. Further college provides separate writer, if required, and if asked to the examinee but only to the student who is unable to write due to severe injury in student's workable hand or the student who has no hands. The college also takes precautions while providing writer that the writer should not belong to the same class of the examinee and does not have any knowledge about the subject.
7. As the college has lavatories with Indian toilets and are unsuitable to divyangjan students. So the college has provided toilet seat/chair to the student for their convenience. They can request to peon for the same and that will be provided immediately.
8. All the faculty members and non-teaching staff are instructed to support the blind students. Writer or helper is provided to such students.

Though the college provides all the facilities mentioned above, comparatively very few (one or two) divyangjan students or physically challenged students were admitted in the college during the last few years. Still the college takes all the necessary steps to protect the fundamental rights of the divyangjan or physically challenged students and help them by almost all means.

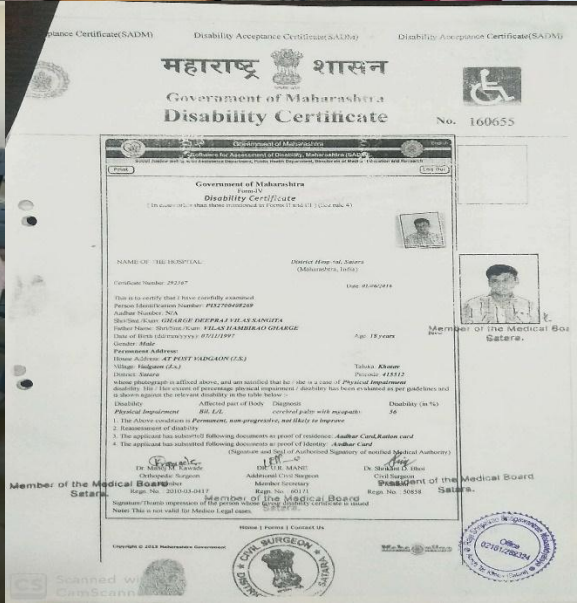
Built up environment with ramps

Disabled friendly washroom

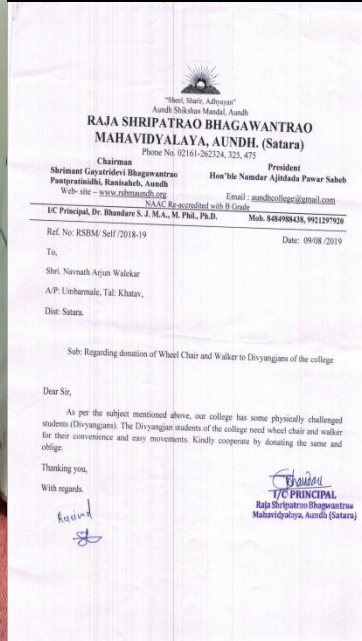


Facilities for person with disability


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
